## **SOME OF THE PURPOSE** LITERACY USED **Reading Comprehension** Understanding written sentences and paragraphs in work related documents. Reads bill of lading to determine assignment Writing Communicating effectively in writing as appropriate for the needs of the audience. Maintains driver log according to regulations. Documents weight of load. Inspects truck before and after trips and submits report indicating truck condition. **Documenting/Recording Information** Entering, transcribing, recording, storing, or maintaining information in written or electronic/magnetic form. **Processing Information** Compiling, coding, categorizing, calculating, tabulating, auditing, or verifying information or data. **Getting Information** Observing, receiving, and otherwise obtaining information from all relevant sources Applying knowledge Reading and understanding commercial driving regulations, and applying these to transport and deliver products, livestock, or materials, usually over long distance. **Performing Administrative Activities** Performing day-to-day administrative tasks such as maintaining information files and processing paperwork.
